- THURSDAY, 10/22**: Personal Protection Equipment (*Supplies limited- please call ahead) (with a face mask icon)
- FRIDAY, 10/23**: Food (with a food container icon)

Today, we will be distributing hats, scarves, and gloves, many of which were hand made by the members of the Sparta Woman's Club!

Tuesday, Nick's Hope will be setting up outside our office with a wide variety of gently used clothing, coats, shoes, etc., for anyone in need to browse and "shop" for free! Nick's hope will be arriving at 10AM to set up.

On Wednesday, we will be distributing beautiful, handmade quilts donated by Quilting for a Cause. These exquisite quilts are valued at around \$125 each! With the colder weather quickly approaching, it is important to make sure our clients and neighbors remain warm!

If you know someone struggling to obtain PPE, please have them call our office. We have a limited supply of masks and sanitizer that we can distribute to help prevent the spread of COVID, but all recipients must call ahead.

Friday will be our Friday Food Day! Throughout the pandemic, our amazing volunteers who we have lovingly nicknamed our "Food Fairies" have donated and distributed over \$22,000 worth of food to our families. On Friday, we will be distributing some of that food to anyone in need.

This year has been incredibly difficult for everyone, but just imagine how much more difficult it has been for the families in the midst of a housing crisis. When you don't have a home, how are you supposed to stay at home? Wash your hands? Self-isolate? Disinfect? These are the troubling questions that we encounter on a daily basis.
