2020 RFQ for Concession Services

The Borough of Franklin is interested in obtaining an individual or organization (vendor) to provide services for operating the Borough's concession stand at the park at the Franklin Pond for the 2020 season. The vendor who is awarded the contract to operate the concession stand, will staff, stock, and supervise all aspects of operations. Compensation to the Borough will be determined.

The equipment that is owned by the Borough of Franklin, will be inspected and inventoried by representatives of the Borough Recreation Committee and/or the Borough of Franklin. All equipment owned by the Borough of Franklin shall be returned at the end of the season in good working order. Any damage determined to be identified, will be the responsibility of the contractor to repair or replace. A signed (by Borough & Vendor) form documenting all inventory prior to use and after, will be required and a deposit may be required. Any vendor contracts will be between the organization who is awarded this RFQ and the vendor.

Vendor will be responsible for disposing of garbage associated with the operation of the concession stand and the garbage can be disposed of in the Borough's dumpster near the Franklin Senior Center. The DPW will also empty the exterior garbage cans surrounding the concession stand and will clean and maintain (and provide paper products) for the bathrooms attached to the concession stand, and the vendor and public will have access to the bathrooms.

The group who is the awarded vendor must have required insurance coverage and provide a Hold Harmless Agreement to be approved by the Borough Attorney and the Borough's Risk Manager.

- Vendor must provide three (3) references.
- Vendor must have an excellent safety history.
- Vendor must provide all paperwork, fees, forms, etc. as required by the state of New Jersey to the appropriate bureaus and/or departments.
- Vendor must provide all paperwork, fees, forms, etc. as required by the Borough of Franklin to the appropriate bureaus and/or departments.

Hours of operation can be set by the vendor in conjunction with the field use or to coincide with park hours. Vendor must comply with the Borough of Franklin Noise Ordinance Chapter 184. No music or excessive lighting before 8:00AM and after 10:00PM. The Borough will pay electric and internet costs. Note: AC unit, lights and water should all be used within reason. All staff vehicles must be parked on the grass opposite the concession stand. The vendor will be permitted to use existing picnic tables, but they must be returned in the condition which there were presented.
