ORDINANCE # 11-2010

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE TOTAL SUM OF \$42,000.00 FROM GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR FUNDING IMPROVEMENTS TO MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS BY THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin, County of Sussex, New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: The sum of forty-two thousand dollars (\$42,000.00) to be utilized out of the General Capital Improvement Fund is hereby appropriated for the following purpose:

For Various Improvements to Municipal Building and Grounds for the Borough of Franklin.

Section 2: In connection with the amount authorized in Section 1 hereof, the Borough makes the following determination:

(a) The purpose described in Section 1 hereof is not a Current Expense and is an improvement, which the Borough of Franklin may lawfully make as general capital improvement.

(b) The period of usefulness of the purpose described in section 1 hereof is not in the limitations of the said Local Bond Law and according to the aggregate reasonable life thereof is five (5) years.

Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance, be and the same is hereby-repealed ton to the extent of there inconsistency:

Section 4: This ordinance becomes effective immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
