ORDINANCE # 9-2011

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:9-135 provide that the Borough may create the position of Deputy Clerk;

WHEREAS, Budget constraints have forced the Borough to re-examine all positions;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have concluded that the clerk's office can function efficiently without an appointed Deputy Clerk;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of Franklin, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey that the Code of the Borough of Franklin is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1.

Sections 5-18 and 5-19 of the Code of the Borough of Franklin are hereby deleted and reserved for future use. Article shall be re-titled "Borough Clerk".

Section 2.


All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.
