Ordinance # 14-2017**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 259 "PARKING," Code of the
Borough of Franklin § 259-5**

WHEREAS, the Franklin Borough Mayor and Council finds and declares the promotion of vehicular and pedestrian safety on the Borough's streets and roads is of paramount concern; and

WHEREAS, Franklin Borough desires to amend certain specific parking requirements under the Code of the Borough of Franklin §259-5, as more specifically stated below;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Franklin Borough Mayor and Council amends the Borough Code as follows with **bolded & underlined text** representing new text to be added as part of this amendment, and ~~strikethrough text~~ representing deleted text as follows:

Chapter 259 "Parking"

Section §259-5

...

D. Stopping or standing prohibited anytime. No person shall stop or stand a vehicle on any day (except Sundays and public holidays) upon any of the streets or parts of streets described.


Names of Street	Side	Location
Buckwheat Rd	West	From Parker Street to Washington Avenue, westerly side, for a distance of 1,000 feet
County Route 517 (Munsonhurst Road)	Both	Franklin Borough - Ogdensburg Borough border to State Route 23
Fowler Street (part o County Route 631)	Both	From North Church Road to Church Street (part of County Route 631)
Franklin Avenue (pa of County Route 631	South	From State Route 23 to Corkhill Road
High Street	Both	From Main Street to State Route 23
Mabie Street	South	Opposite the intersection of Mabie Street and Moscow Street for a distance of 25 feet in a westerly and easterly direction from the center line of the intersection of the two streets
Mabie Street	South	From State Route 23 for a distance of 60 feet in an easterly direction
Main Street	South	South From High Street to Rutherford Avenue
Maple Road	South	From Corkhill Road to Wildcat Road

Rutherford Avenue	West	From State Route 23 to Scott Road
School Plaza	West	From Washington Avenue, southerly direction, for a distance of 350 feet
Washington Avenue	North	From Buckwheat Road, easterly direction, for a distance of 400 feet
Washington Avenue	South	From Buckwheat Road to Rt. 23, southerly side, for a distance of 950 feet
<u>Main Street</u>	<u>North</u>	<u>From Mill Street, in each direction on the side Mill Street intersects with Main Street, for a distance of 25 feet.</u>

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances or resolutions inconsistent or in opposition to the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed in their entirety; and,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this ordinance shall take effect after its final passage and publication as required by law.


