
RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A “DEDICATION BY RIDER” TO THE BUDGET OF THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN FOR MOBILE VIDEO RECORDING SYSTEMS FOR POLICE VEHICLES PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 39:4-50(i)

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-39 provides for the insertions of a “Dedication by Rider” in the budget of any local unit which dedicates revenues anticipated during the fiscal year from revenues, subject to written prior consent of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, when the revenue is not subject to reasonable accurate estimate in advance; and

WHEREAS, under N.J.S.A. 39:4-50(i) the additional surcharge for DWI convictions provides revenue for the purchase of mobile video recording systems for police vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin, County of Sussex, State of New Jersey that all revenue received pursuant to NJSA 39: 4-50(i) by the Borough of Franklin be placed in a specific trust fund and such trust fund shall be considered a “Dedication by Rider” to the budget of the local unit, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-50(i), for the sole purpose stated above.
