Ms. Fantasia commented she reviewed and compared the 2 RFP's submitted by Laddey Clark & Ryan and Schenck, Price, Smith & King LLP for the Borough Attorney position as well as speaking with the CFO, Administrator and Mayor Giordano regarding costs for various services. Ms. Fantasia also commented based on merit alone we can't lose with either firm. However, from a finance perspective Ms. Fantasia recommends Laddey Clark & Ryan, Tom Prol, Esq. to be the fiscally responsible choice between the 2 proposals and saving significant tax payer dollars.

Mr. Skellenger commented he would agree with Ms. Fantasia in that both are experienced attorneys and we can't lose, however from a financial standpoint Laddey Clark & Ryan will be a more cost effective for the Borough.

Mayor Giordano commented on the costs the Borough had to incur for outside labor attorney fees which must be added to the Laddey Clark & Ryan retainer to be a fair cost comparison. Mayor Giordano also commented choosing Schenck, Price, Smith & King LLP gives us an opportunity to utilize attorneys within their firm that specialize in various fields if the need arises. Mayor Giordano announced we will continue to use the current outside labor attorney to finish up on what has been started, the FOP and other union contracts should be completed hopefully by the end of the month. Mayor Giordano recommends Schenck, Price, Smith & King LLP for what the Borough needs this year and asks the Council to approve that recommendation.

Mr. Snyder commented Mr. Prol has been a very good attorney for our town for a number of years. Mr. Snyder also commented the Borough would be fortunate with either firm. Mr. Snyder recommended with Mr. Prol's many interests Schenck, Price, Smith & King LLP would be a better firm moving forward.

A discussion continued on the recommendation for the Borough Attorney.

Mr. Rathbun commented it is a very difficult decision, both are very good attorneys. Mr. Rathbun suggested we should come up with a better scope of comparisons when going out for future RFP's.
