## **ORDINANCE #17-2010**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE TOTAL SUM OF \$70,000.00 FROM GENERAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR FUNDING VARIOUS GENERAL CAPITAL PURCHASES OR PURPOSES BY THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY.

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin, County of Sussex, New Jersey, as follows:

**Section 1:** The sum of Seventy Thousand dollars (\$70,000.00) to be utilized out of the General Capital Improvement Fund is hereby appropriated for the following purpose:

For Various General Capital Improvements or Purposes for the Borough of Franklin.

- **Section 2:** In connection with the amount authorized in Section 1 hereof, the Borough makes the following determination:
- (a) The purpose described in Section 1 hereof is not a Current Expense and is an improvement, which the Borough of Franklin may lawfully make as general capital improvement.
- (b) The period of usefulness of the purpose described in section 1 hereof is not in the limitations of the said Local Bond Law and according to the aggregate reasonable life thereof is five (5) years.
- **Section 3:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances, which are inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance, be and the same is hereby-repealed ton to the extent of there inconsistency:
- **Section 4:** This ordinance becomes effective immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
