Storm Recovery Reserve Funds


WHEREAS, the Borough of Franklin has a Storm Recovery Reserve Fund; and

WHEREAS, any reimbursement of these expenses shall be deposited back into the Reserve.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the mayor and council of the Borough of Franklin that the Storm Recovery Reserve Funds be used for any expenses relating to the Covid 19 in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-62.1 and hereby approved.
