AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 161 OF THE FRANKLIN BOROUGH CODE, ALLOWING FIRST FLOOR RESIDENTIAL ON SOME LOTS IN THE B-2 ZONE

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin as follows:

Section 1. Schedule A to the Land Use Ordinance is amended to indicate that the phrase "upper floors only" for apartments in the B-2 Zone shall not apply to Block 602 Lot 25; Block 607 Lots 18, 19 and 20; and Block 608 Lot 12 which shall permit residential uses on all floors in the B-2 Zone.

The amended Schedule A attached to this Ordinance.

Section 2. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance or the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance shall not be affected and shall remain in full force and effect.
