**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN,  
COUNTY OF SUSSEX, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY  
AMENDING SECTION 119-2, FEES**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin, County of Sussex, and State of New Jersey that the Code of the Borough of Franklin is hereby amended as follows:

**SECTION I.**

Chapter 119-2, Fees is amended to update Section A, fees for duplicate tax bills, additional duplicate tax bills, and fees for checks returned for insufficient funds. The specific fees in Section A are hereby amended as follows:

<b>Description</b>	<b>Fee</b>
Duplicate tax bill	\$5
Each additional duplicate requested by mortgage companies in the same calendar year	\$25
Check returned for insufficient funds	\$20

**SECTION II**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

**SECTION III**

If any article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, said article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence shall be deemed severable.

**SECTION IV**


This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final publication as provided by law.
