

**BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN
ORDINANCE NUMBER 09-2026**

**CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PURCHASE OF
UPFITTING FOR THE NEW POLICE CARS FOR THE POLICE
DEPARTMENT, BY AND IN THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN, IN
THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AND
APPROPRIATING \$18,531.00 THEREFOR FROM THE CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THIS PURCHASE**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, State of New Jersey (the "Borough"), needs to upfit the newly purchased Tahoe and Silverado; and

WHEREAS, the cost of a portion of said improvements or purposes is estimated to be \$18,531.00; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to authorize the appropriation and expenditure of \$18,531.00 from the capital improvement fund to upfit these vehicles.

**BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AS
FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. The capital improvements or purposes described below are hereby authorized as the Purchase of Server and Printer for the Police Department be undertaken by the Borough. For the said improvements or purposes, there is hereby appropriated the amount of \$18,531.00 from the capital improvement fund.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect immediately after final adoption and approval by the Mayor as described in N.J.S.A. 40:49-2.

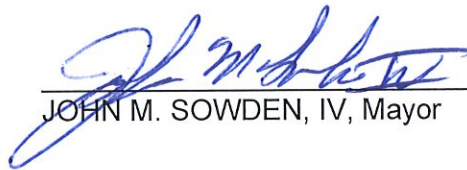
