RESOLUTION OF THE FRANKLIN BOROUGH COUNCIL REQUESTING THE TAX ASSESSOR TO PRESENT THE BOROUGH'S REQUEST FOR A MULTIYEAR PROPERTY REASSESSMENT AT A MEETING WITH THE COUNTY TAX BOARD AND SEEK THEIR SUPPORT AND AUTHORIZATION TO FURTHER PURSUE THIS COURSE OF ACTION

WHEREAS, Franklin Borough has had a dramatic decrease in its Assessment Ratio over the past 2 years due to the well documented rise in property values over that same time period, with this ratio change being fueled primarily by the residential market sector; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Tax Assessor has advised that the sales being included in the active state sampling period show a continued decline in ratio; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has committed to the annual maintenance of the Tax Map thru the consulting firm Civil Solutions (aka Adams, Rehmann & Heggan), with said maps reflecting all recent changes; and

WHEREAS the Borough Tax Assessor has expressed caution regarding the potential for increased commercial tax appeal activity resulting from the excessive ratio drop, and has advised that it would be appropriate for the Borough to authorize the Assessor to discuss with the Sussex County Board of Taxation the need for a Complete Reassessment, and thereafter the potential for conducting Annual Reassessments in accordance with a multi-year reassessment program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Borough Council of Franklin Borough has accepted the Tax Assessor's recommendation for a Complete Reassessment and subsequent Annual Reassessment Program over several years, provided that he obtaines from the Sussex County Board of Taxation their approval to proceed in this direction in a timely manner.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Borough Council of Franklin Borough is requesting that the Tax Assessor appear at a meeting with the County Tax Board so that the Tax Assessor can present the Borough's position and seek their support and authorization to further pursue this course of action.

A CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AUTHORIZE THE APPROPRIATION OF CAPITAL FUNDS FOR THE CUTTER ASSEMBLIES AT THE RT. 23 SOUTH AND MAPLE ROAD SEWER PUMPING STATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin, County of Sussex, and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The cutter/grinder assemblies at the Rt. 23 south and Maple Road sewer pumping stations need to be rebuilt; and,

The Franklin Borough Director of Public Works has received an estimate of the cost of the necessary parts from the North Jersey Wastewater Cooperative Pricing System, and the installation of these parts will be handled by borough employees. The Chief Financial Officer certifies the availability of funds in Account #08-229-55-000-000 Reserve for Capital Improvements – Sewer Stations for the completion of the project with a cost not to exceed \$30,000; and,

Section 3. The Borough hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget or a temporary capital budget, as applicable. The capital or temporary capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital or temporary capital budget, a revised capital or temporary capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
