#### **ORDINANCE No. 14-2022**

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SUSSEX, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY MODIFYING SECTION 259-2 REGARDING PARKING

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin, County of Sussex, and State of New Jersey that the Franklin Borough Code is amended as follows:

**SECTION I.** Subsection 259-2E of the Code is hereby replaced as follows:

#### § 259-2E. Parking time limited on Main Street.

Parking time limited on Main Street. No person shall park a vehicle for longer than the time limit between

the hours listed on any day (except Sundays and public holidays) upon the portion of Main Street

described:

(1) Southbound:

(a) Rutherford Avenue to Hudson Street: unlimited parking.

(b) Church Street to Caitlin Road: unlimited parking.

(c) Caitlan Road to Lehigh Street: two-hour parking between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm

with unlimited parking on Sundays and Holidays.

(2) Northbound:

(a) Church Street to Town Hall: no parking.

(b) Front of Town Hall: official parking only (police, fire, EMS).

(c) Town Hall to High Street: two-hour parking between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm with

unlimited parking on Sundays and Holidays.

(d) High Street to Junction Street: no parking.

(e) Junction Street to Parker Street: two-hour parking between the hours of 8:00 am and 4:00 pm

with unlimited parking on Sundays and Holidays.

(f) Parker Street to Rutherford Avenue: no parking.

(3) Borough Municipal Building parking lot: parking prohibited in spaces labelled employee parking;

Otherwise, unlimited parking provided that applicable fees are paid.

#### **SECTION II**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistencies.

#### SECTION III

If any article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, said article, section, subsection, paragraph, phrase or sentence shall be deemed severable.

#### **SECTION IV**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final publication as provided by law.
