BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Franklin, County of Sussex, and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Franklin Borough Water Sewer Department has a need for two Ford 350 Pick Up Trucks with Plows; and,

Section 2. The Franklin Borough Water Sewer Department has requested that Franklin Borough purchase the essential equipment and has provided a quote for the purchase utilizing New Jersey State Contract T-2959 and will be funded from the capital improvement fund and shall not exceed \$128,844; and,

Section 3. The Borough hereby certifies that it has adopted a capital budget and the capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. To the extent that the purposes authorized herein are inconsistent with the adopted capital budget, a revised capital budget has been filed with the Division of Local Government Services.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
