





## ABOUT US

The Franklin Borough Police Department was established in 1915, and consisted of one officer who patrolled on horseback. The police department now consists of 17 sworn law enforcement officers comprised of a Chief, a Captain, 2 Lieutenants, 3 Sergeants, 2 Detectives, and 8 Patrol Officers.

Officers patrol an area of approximately 5 square miles with a population of approximately 5,000. Franklin Borough consists of 26 miles of roadway, with approximately 100,000 vehicles traveling our major roadways each week. Our officers initiate and/or respond to over 10,000 calls for service each year.

## GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

- No person shall be appointed to the police department who is not qualified as provided in the New Jersey statutes.
- Must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of the State of New Jersey.
- Must be at least eighteen (18) years of age.
- Must possess a New Jersey driver's license.
- Must be of good moral character, and has not been convicted of any criminal offense involving moral turpitude.
- Read, write, and speak the English language well and intelligently.
- Must possess the ability to perform all the tasks and duties of a police officer.
- Must pass a medical and psychological examination, extensive background investigation and drug screening.
- Must be a high school graduate or possess GED.
- Must have completed a minimum of sixty (60) college credits from an accredited college or university, or two (2) years of military service with an honorable discharge.
