

EXTRACT from the minutes of a regular meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, held at the Municipal Building, 46 Main Street, Franklin, New Jersey, on June 25, 2019, at 7:00 o'clock P.M.

Mr. Limon introduced and moved the adoption of the following resolution and **Mr. Soules** seconded the motion:

RESOLUTION #2019-61 AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF NOT EXCEEDING \$2,193,099 BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES OF THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN, IN THE COUNTY OF SUSSEX, NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to a bond ordinance of The Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex (the "Borough") entitled: "Bond ordinance providing for the improvement of the water and sewer systems in and by the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, appropriating \$850,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$809,000 bonds or notes of the Borough for financing such appropriation", finally adopted on November 24, 2009 (#16-2009), bond anticipation notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$65,500 shall be issued for the purpose of temporarily financing the improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of said bond ordinance, including (to any extent necessary) the renewal of any bond anticipation notes heretofore issued therefor.

Section 2. Pursuant to a bond ordinance of the Borough entitled: "Bond ordinance appropriating \$250,000, and authorizing the issuance of \$225,000 bonds or notes of the Borough, for various improvements or purposes authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey", finally adopted on December 8, 2009 (#19-2009), bond anticipation notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$20,767 shall be issued for the purpose of temporarily financing the improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of said bond ordinance, including (to any extent necessary) the renewal of any bond anticipation notes heretofore issued therefor.

Section 3. Pursuant to a bond ordinance of the Borough entitled: "Bond ordinance providing for the improvement of various roads in and by the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, appropriating \$255,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$242,500 bonds or notes of the Borough for financing such appropriation", finally adopted on September 24, 2013 (#11-2013), bond anticipation notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$92,083 shall be issued for the purpose of temporarily financing the improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of said bond ordinance, including (to any extent necessary) the renewal of any bond anticipation notes heretofore issued therefor.

Section 4. Pursuant to a bond ordinance of the Borough entitled: "Bond ordinance providing for the improvement of the fire house in and by the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, appropriating \$20,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$19,000 bonds or notes of the Borough for financing such appropriation", finally adopted on September 24, 2013 (#12-2013), bond anticipation notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$6,233 shall be issued for the purpose of temporarily financing the improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of said bond ordinance, including (to any extent necessary) the renewal of any bond anticipation notes heretofore issued therefor.

Section 5. Pursuant to a bond ordinance of the Borough entitled: "Bond ordinance appropriating \$1,796,000, and authorizing the issuance of \$1,536,000 bonds or notes of the Borough, for various improvements or purposes authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey", finally adopted on June 24, 2014 (#8-2014), bond anticipation notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$741,600 shall be issued for the purpose of temporarily financing the improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of said bond ordinance, including (to any extent necessary) the renewal of any bond anticipation notes heretofore issued therefor.

Section 6. Pursuant to a bond ordinance of the Borough entitled: "Bond ordinance appropriating \$379,300, and authorizing the issuance of \$227,300 bonds or notes of the Borough, for various improvements or purposes authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey", finally adopted on June 23, 2015 (#7-2015), bond anticipation notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$129,735 shall be issued for the purpose of temporarily financing the improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of said bond ordinance, including (to any extent necessary) the renewal of any bond anticipation notes heretofore issued therefor.

Section 7. Pursuant to a bond ordinance of the Borough entitled: "Bond ordinance appropriating \$475,665, and authorizing the issuance of \$453,000 bonds or notes of the Borough, for various improvements or purposes authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey", finally adopted on July 12, 2016 (#15-2016), bond anticipation notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$45,511 shall be issued for the purpose of temporarily financing the improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of said bond ordinance, including (to any extent necessary) the renewal of any bond anticipation notes heretofore issued therefor.

Section 8. Pursuant to a bond ordinance of the Borough entitled: “Bond ordinance providing for the acquisition of new vehicles for use by the water and sewer systems of the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, appropriating \$95,700 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$91,000 bonds or notes of the Borough for financing such appropriation”, finally adopted on July 12, 2016 (#16-2016), bond anticipation notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$50,500 shall be issued for the purpose of temporarily financing the improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of said bond ordinance, including (to any extent necessary) the renewal of any bond anticipation notes heretofore issued therefor.

Section 9. Pursuant to a bond ordinance of the Borough entitled: “Bond ordinance appropriating \$623,846, and authorizing the issuance of \$395,300 bonds or notes of the Borough, for various improvements or purposes authorized to be undertaken by the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey”, finally adopted on June 25, 2019 (#9-2017), bond anticipation notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$311,270 shall be issued for the purpose of temporarily financing the improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of said bond ordinance, including (to any extent necessary) the renewal of any bond anticipation notes heretofore issued therefor.

Section 10. Pursuant to a bond ordinance of the Borough entitled: “Bond ordinance providing for the acquisition of a new fire truck by the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, appropriating \$600,000 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$475,000 bonds or notes of the Borough for financing such appropriation”, finally adopted on November 14, 2017 (#16-2017), bond anticipation notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$427,500 shall be issued for the purpose of temporarily financing the

improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of said bond ordinance, including (to any extent necessary) the renewal of any bond anticipation notes heretofore issued therefor.

Section 11. Pursuant to a bond ordinance of the Borough entitled: "Bond ordinance providing for the improvement of various roads in and by the Borough of Franklin, in the County of Sussex, New Jersey, appropriating \$493,140 therefor and authorizing the issuance of \$336,000 bonds or notes of the Borough for financing such appropriation", finally adopted on June 25, 2019 (#10-2018), bond anticipation notes of the Borough in a principal amount not exceeding \$302,400 shall be issued for the purpose of temporarily financing the improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of said bond ordinance, including (to any extent necessary) the renewal of any bond anticipation notes heretofore issued therefor.

Section 12. All bond anticipation notes (the "notes") issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the treasurer, the chief financial officer or the acting chief financial officer of the Borough (the "Chief Financial Officer"), provided that no note shall mature later than one year from its date. The notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer and shall be signed and sealed by officials and officers of the Borough in any manner permitted by N.J.S.A. §40A:2-25. The Chief Financial Officer shall determine all matters in connection with the notes issued hereunder, and the Chief Financial Officer's signature upon the notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. §40A:2-8. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the notes at not less than par from time to time at public or private sale and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price. The Chief Financial Officer is directed to report in writing to the governing body of the Borough at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the

notes hereunder is made. Such report must include the principal amount, interest rate and maturities of the notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.

Section 13. Any note issued pursuant to this resolution shall be a general obligation of the Borough, and the Borough's faith and credit are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the notes and, unless otherwise paid or payment provided for, an amount sufficient for such payment shall be inserted in the budget and a tax sufficient to provide for the payment thereof shall be levied and collected.

Section 14. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized and directed to do all other matters necessary, useful, convenient or desirable to accomplish the delivery of the notes to the purchasers thereof as promptly as possible, including (i) the preparation, execution and dissemination of a Preliminary Official Statement and Final Official Statement with respect to the notes, (ii) preparation, distribution and publication, if necessary, of a Notice of Sale with respect to the notes, (iii) execution of a Continuing Disclosure Undertaking, with respect to the notes in accordance with Rule 15c2-12 promulgated by the Securities and Exchange Commission and (iv) execution of an arbitrage and use of proceeds certificate certifying that, among other things, the Borough, to the extent it is empowered and allowed under applicable law, will do and perform all acts and things necessary or desirable to assure that interest paid on the notes is not included in gross income under Section 103 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

Section 15. All action heretofore taken by Borough officials and professionals with regard to the sale and award of the notes is hereby ratified, confirmed, adopted and approved.

Section 16. This resolution shall take effect immediately.


