## Resolution #2024-128

### RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE BOROUGH OF FRANKLIN AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF VEHICLE

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Hardyston, owns a 2013 Ford Explorer, (the “Vehicle”), previously utilized by the Hardyston Township Fire Department and currently not in use by the Township;

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Hardyston wishes to sell the Vehicle to the Borough of Franklin for a purchase price of four thousand five hundred (\$4,500.00) dollars;

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Hardyston is authorized to convey the Vehicle to the Borough of Franklin, pursuant to the Local Lands and Buildings Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13, et seq.;

**WHEREAS**, the Township of Hardyston authorized the sale of the Vehicle via the approval of Ordinance #2024-20 on December 11, 2024, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13, et seq.;

**WHEREAS**, the CFO has reviewed the purchase, recommends an agreement be executed to authorize the sale, and certifies that funds are available;

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council believes that this is a necessary and appropriate purchase and expenditure;

**NOW THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED** by the Governing Body of the Borough of Franklin that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Township of Hardyston to purchase the 2013 Ford Explorer from the Township for a price of \$4,500.00.
