ABOUT US

The Franklin Borough Police Department was established in 1915, and consisted of one officer who patrolled on horseback. The police department now consists of 18 sworn law enforcement officers comprised of a Chief, Captain, Lieutenant, 5 Sergeants, 2 Detectives, and 8 Patrol Officers.

Officers patrol an area of approximately 5 square miles with a population of approximately 5,000. Franklin Borough consists of 26 miles of roadway, with approximately 100,000 vehicles traveling our major roadways each week. Our officers initiate and/or respond to over 10,000 calls for service each year.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

- No person shall be appointed to the police department who is not qualified as provided in the New Jersey statutes;
- Must be at least twenty-one (21) years of age;
- Must be a resident of New Jersey and a citizen of the United States;
- Must possess a valid New Jersey driver's license;
- Must read, write, and speak the English language well and intelligently;
- Shall have graduated from high school or possess a General Equivalency Degree (GED);
- Must have completed a minimum of sixty (60) credits from an accredited college or university, or two (2) years of military service with an honorable discharge;
- Ability to perform all the tasks and duties of a Police Officer;
- Must be of good moral character and have not been convicted of any criminal offense involving moral turpitude.
- The Borough may require as a condition of application that the applicant must possess a police training certificate issued by the NJ PTC, be a graduate or enrolled in a State of New Jersey Alternate Route Training program.
